



# GHIYASUDDIN INTERNATIONAL SCHOOL UNIFORM



For all students

- Students should wear sports uniform on the days they have PE lessons and for activities requiring this uniform which will be informed by the school.
- Students can wear sports shoes or similar kind of shoes with their sports unifrom. But are not allowed to wear tennis shoes.
- Students are not allowed to wear the activity uniform other than for school purposes.



### NOTE:

# Shirt:

- Girls should have rounded collar and boys should have pointed collar.
- Girls can wear short or long sleeved shirts. Sleeves of the girls shirt (if short sleeved) should not be shorter than 2 inches above the elbow.
- Length of the girls' shirts should reach upto mid thigh.

#### Skirts, shorts and trousers

- School skirts, shorts and trousers must not be sewn by denim or satin materials. Material available from school or any other similar material can be used.
- Any other black material or
- Divided skirt (with two box pleats per side) must be 2 inches below the knee
- Trousers and shorts should have two pleats of one inch width each at the front on both sides. Trousers should reach upto the ankle.
- The length of the boys shorts should reach the knee.

## General

- Colour of Short, Trouser, Skirt, Veil, Socks & Shoes should be black
- Girls & Boys Shirt should be Purple thin striped material endorsed by the school.
- Orange coloured normal or sports veil can be used with the sports uniform
- The school badge should be on the left side.
- Boys should tuck their uniforms neatly under the shorts or trousers and belt must be seen.
- The belt should be black in colour.
- The length of the socks should reach atleast half way between the knee and the ankle.
- Scarf and tie will be used only by student council members.
- Girl's hair should be neatly combed and plaited with black ribbon and boys should have their hair cut short. Fancy hair cuts are not allowed.
- Girls who wear jewelry should be kept to a minimum of one gold or silver ear stud per ear. (Hoops and dangling earrings should not be worn) Wrist watches(non-electronic) are allowed for grade 6 and above students only.
