



SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINE – NEED BASED

Introduction

The Need based scholarship is provided to eligible students applying for admission for the Academic year 2025.

1. The total number of scholarship seats offered will be 3 in number for the grade specified. The scholarship offer is; **Need Based Scholarship**.
2. The scholarship is valid for Maldivian residents only.

Eligibility

1. Applicable for Maldivian students who are eligible for admission in Grade 1 for the **Academic year 2025**
2. 3 scholarship seats open for Grade 1 only
3. The income of both the parents / guardian from all sources should not be more than MVR **360,000** per year, (if the child is registered where other than Greater Male' area).
4. The income of both the parents / guardian from all sources should not be more than MVR **240,000** per year, (if the child is registered in Greater Male' area).
 - Parent must submit the Bank statement of all accounts and the details of all incomes.
 - Self-employed income must be validated by the authorized body such as MIRA / law firms / Ministry of Economic Development / Banks etc.
5. The child for the scholarship should pass from the Minimum Learning Competency Test.
6. Lots will be drawn among students if the number of the eligible applicants, (in case the MLC Test result is the same).
7. The Test will be conducted in the subjects of Mathematics, English, and Dhivehi
8. The scholarship is applicable from the beginning of the **academic year 2025** and covers the entire school education period at GIS if the eligibility conditions are met with each successive year.
9. The scholarship would cover the monthly tuition fee and one-time admission fee charged by the school.
10. The names of the selected students will be displayed on the school website and on the Facebook official page.
11. The scholarship can be discontinued for the following reasons:
 - a. If it is found at any stage that the information furnished by the parents/ guardians is untrue
 - b. If the student is already availing of any other form of scholarship or financial assistance for the purposes of the child's studies.
 - c. For students studying in grade 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 the scholarship shall be renewed based on the criterion of parental income continuing to be less than or equal to the threshold limit as per Rule 3 & 4.
 - d. The scholarship for students studying grade 7, 8, 9 and 10 will be renews every year if the concerned students score 65% or more in results obtained in the final exams and their parental income is less than or equal to the threshold limit as defined under rule 3 & 4.
